ote 1:

Public Holidays on account of Birthday of Swami Vivekananda (January), Republic Day (January 26th) and Doljatra (March 16th) fall on Sundays. Executive holiday on account of Janmastami (August 17th) falls on Sunday. Public Holiday on account of Birthday of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar (April 14th) coincides with the traditional Court Holiday on account of Chaitra Sankranti. Sectional holiday on account of Sabe-Barat (June 14th) falls on 2nd Saturday.

e 2:

If any of the Muslim Festivals notified above does not fall on the day notified, Muslim officials and employees of City Civil Court, Calcutta may be granted a holiday on the day on which the festival is actually observed in addition to the holiday on the day notified.

e 3:

Sectional holiday on account of Buddha Purnima (May 14th) may be granted, when possible to Buddhist employees. Sectional holiday on account of Rakhi (April 14th) coincides with Public holiday on account of Birth day of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and traditional Court holiday on account of Chitra Sankranti. Sectional holiday on account of Mahabir Jayanti (April 13th) falls on Sunday. All officials, Suitors and Witnesses who profess the Brahmo faith may be granted, when possible 3(three) days' holidays on account of Maghotsav one day before and one day after that date.

e 4:

The Executive holiday on account of Birth Day of the Nepali Poet Bhanu Prasad (July 13th) falls on Sunday.

e 5:

The Chief Judge, City Civil Court, Calcutta may be empowered to declare holidays not exceeding two days in a year according to prevalent customs after consultation with the local Bar Association.

e 6:

All 2nd and 4th Saturdays of months have been declared as holidays for the Courts Subordinate to the High Court in West Bengal vide F.C. Resolution dated 06.08.1992.
