

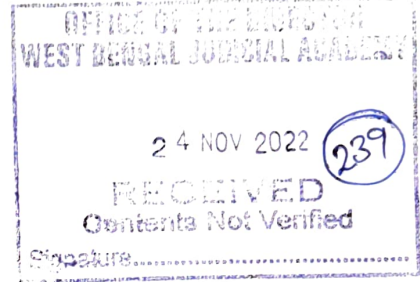

Note 2 : Public Holidays on account of Easter Saturday (April 8th) and Mahalaya (October 14th) fall on Second Saturday.

Note 3 : Holidays on account of Muslim Festivals viz. Id-ul-Fitre, Id-uz-Zoha (Bakrid) and Muharram will be declared later on, depending on visibility of the moon, as desired by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Note 4 : Sectional Holiday on account of Sab-E-Barat (March 8th) coincide with Holi. Sectional holiday on account of Mahabir Jayanti (April 4th) may be granted, when possible, to the Jain employees. Sectional holiday on account of Baisakhi (April 14th) coincides with the Chaitra Sankranti falls on Friday.

Note 5 : In accordance with Full Court resolution dated 6.8.1992 Second and Fourth Saturdays of the respective calendar month have been declared as Court Holidays.

Note 6 : In accordance with the Full Court resolution dated 01.12.2015 in the event of High Court declares as unscheduled Holiday, The Hon'ble The Chief Justice may exercise discretion to declare any "Non-working Day" as "Working Day" upon 07 (seven) days' notice, on consultation with Bar.

Note 7 : Chief Judge, City Civil Court, Calcutta may be empowered to declare local Holidays not exceeding 2 (two) days in a year according to prevalent customs in consultation with the local Bar Association.
