Note 1:

Executive Holidays on account of 2nd Day of Sreepanchami (February 14th) and Easter Saturday(March 26th) fall on Sunday and 4th Saturday respectively. First two days of X-Mas Vacation, i.e. December 24th and December 25th fall on 4th Saturday and Sunday respectively. Public Holidays on account of Birthday of Netaji Subhas Ch. Bose (January 23rd), Sreepanchami(February 13th) and Birthday of Rabindranath Tagore (May 8th) fall on 4th Saturday, 2nd Saturday and Sunday respectively. Public Holiday on account of Birthday of Dr. B.R.Ambedkar (April 14th) coincides with the Public Holiday on account of Bengali New Year's Day.

Note 2:

If any of the Muslim Festivals notifies above does not fall on the day on the day notified, Muslim officials and employees of City Civil Court, Calcutta may be granted holiday on the day on which the festival is actually observed in addition to the holiday on the day notified.

Note 3:

Sectional Holidays on account of Buddha Purnima (May 21st), Mahabir Jayanti(April 19th) and Sabe Barat (May 23rd) may be granted, when possible to Buddhist, Jain and Muslim employees respectively. Sectional Holiday on account of Baisakhi (April 13th) coincides with Executive Holiday on account of Chaitra Sankranti. All officials, Suitors and Witnesses who profess the Brahmo faith may be granted, when possible, 3(three) days' holidays on account of Maghotsav one day before and one day after that date.

Note 4:

According to prevalent customs in consultation with the local Bar Association, January 25th(Monday) and August 26th (Friday) are hereby declared as LOCAL HOLIDAYs in the year 2016.

Note 5:

All 2nd and 4th Saturdays of months have been declared as holidays for the Courts Subordinate to the High Court in West Bengal vide F.C. Resolution dated 06.08.1992.
