It is hereby enacted in the Fifty-first Year of the Republic of India, by the Legislature of West Bengal, as follows:—

Short title and commencement

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Bengal, Agra and Assam Civil Courts (West Bengal Amendment) Act, 2000.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by cotification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

2. The Berson Agra and Assam Civil Courts Act. 1887 (herematter referred to s the principal 8ct), shall, in its application to West Bengal, be amended for the purposes and in the manner hereinafter provided.

Amendment of section 19 of Act 12 of 1887

- 3. In section 19 of the principal Act,-
 - (a) in sub-section (1), for the words "fifteen thousand rupees", the words "thirty thousand rupees" shall be substituted;
 - (b) in sub-section (2), for the words "thirty thousand rupees", the words "sixty thousand rupees" shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 21

4. In clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 21 of the principal Act, for the words 'sixty thousand rupces", the words "one lakh and fitty thousand rupces" shall be substituted.
